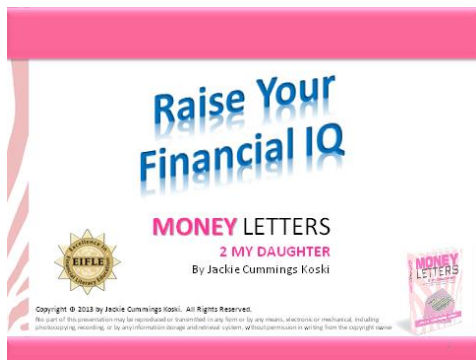

To reach even more people with her important message, Koski created a presentation titled, *Raise Your Financial IQ* which touches on the most essential topics from her book. Today, she travels the country to share her presentation and other personal finance expertise with diverse audiences.
